

(b) The salary established by the city council shall be the full salary receivable by such employees for services to the city. The salary shall be in lieu of all fees or other compensation for their services to the city.

(c) The salary for each commission member shall not exceed the limitation imposed by Section 4.9(h) of the City Charter.

(d) The compensation established by the city council for services provided by the board and commission members shall be as follows:

DMSION 2. BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE

Sec. 2-161. Created.

There is hereby created a beautification committee. (Res. No. 78-195, 4-25-78)

Sec. 2-162. Composition; appointment.

The beautification committee shall be composed of not less than seven (7) members to be appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the city council. (Res. No. 78-195, 425-78)

Sec. 2-163. Terms.

Members of the beautification committee shall serve for a term of one (1) year. (Res. No. 78-195, 425-78)

DMSION 3. HISTORICAL COMMISSION\*

Sec. 2-176. Created.

There is hereby created a historical commission. (Res. No. 85-645, 12-9-85)

Sec. 2-177. Composition; appointment.

The historical commission shall consist of seven (7) members, four (4) of whom shall be appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the city council and three (3) members to be selected by the Romulus Historical Society and approved by the city council. The commission shall remain an entity separate from the Romulus Historical Society. Should the Romulus Historical Society fail to provide the required members the mayor shall fill all vacancies as needed. (Res. No. 85-645, 12-9-85)

Sec. 2-178. Terms.

The members of the historical commission shall serve terms of two (2) years. (Res. No. 85-645, 12-9-85)

**Sec. 2-179. Bylaws.**

The historical commission shall establish by-laws subject to the approval of the city council for conducting its business.

**Sec. 2-180. Officers.**

Members of the historical commission shall **annually** select a chairperson, vice-chairperson and secretary.

**Sec. 2-181. Meetings.**

The historical commission shall meet at least once every three (3) months on a date chosen by the members of the commission and at such times as the commission may deem necessary to conduct its business.

**Sec. 2-182. Compensation.**

The members of the historical commission shall serve as such without compensation.

**Sec. 2-183. Advisory role to mayor and city council.**

The historical commission may advise and assist the mayor and city council relative to **historical** programs upon request.
