This division is hereby determined by **the** city council to be immediately necessary for the interests of the city and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and upon publication as required by law.

## DMSION 4. CITY CRIME COMMISSION\*

### Sec. 2-141. **Created**.

There is hereby created in and for the city a commission hereafter to be known as the city crime commission.

(Code 1967, § 2-1501)

### Sec. 2-142. **Composition; appointment; qualifications**.

The commission shall consist of twelve (12) members, appointed by the mayor, each of whom shall be residents of the city for at least two (2) years. Members of the commission may be persons with qualifications in such areas as: Law enforcement, crime prevention, public communication, and education.

### Sec. 2-143. Commissioner of police, **attendance at meetings**.

The commissioner of police shall be an honorary member of the city crime commission and the commissioner or a representative shall attend all meetings of the commission, unless excused therefrom by the commission.

### Sec. 2-144. **Officers**.

The city crime commission shall each year elect one (1) of its members as chairperson and shall elect such other officers from its membership as it may deem necessary.

### Sec. 2-145. Meetings.

The city crime commission shall hold meetings regularly, at least once in each month, and shall designate the time and place thereof.

### Sec. 2-146. Procedure; **records**.

The city crime commission shall adopt its own rules of procedure and shall keep a record of its proceedings.

### Sec. 2-147. **Purpose and function**.

The purpose and function of the city crime commission shall be to study **the** crime situation in the city on a continuing basis. This study shall include periodic contacts by the commission with members of the community such as school, business and neighborhood leaders as well as police

department personnel. The crime commission shall serve to provide good communication and education within the community about law enforcement and crime prevention. It **shall** recommend any needed changes in procedures to the mayor. The commission should be available to receive citizen questions and complaints about crime and should make recommendations accordingly. (Code 1967, § Z-1506; Ord. No. 80-330, § 1, 12-9-86)

**Sec. 2-148. Scope and extent of duties and powers.**

The scope and extent of the commissions duties and powers **shall** include but not be limited to the following areas:

- (1) Public perceptions of *crime* and law enforcement:
  - a. Public understanding of enforcement procedures;
  - b. Public understanding of available enforcement resources;
- (2) Types and frequency of crime;
- (3) Juvenile delinquency and youth guidance;
- (4) Victims of crime;
- (5) Police needs for personnel, resources and equipment;
- (6) Conduct an annual seminar on crime for the community;
- (7) Ensure that public access cable television be provided police department programming.

**Sec. 2-149. Expenditures.**

Neither the city crime commission, nor any of its members, **shall** incur any expense or create any obligation or liability upon the city. If any expenditure of city funds may be required in connection with the functioning of the commission, prior approval of such expenditures shall first be obtained from the city council.

**DIVISION 5. CULTURAL COMMISSION**

**Sec. 2-161. Created.**

There is hereby created for the city a commission hereafter to be known as the cultural commission.

The cultural commission shall consist of nine (9) members who shall be appointed by the mayor.
