

O.V.F. Garage Sales *7/9*
AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE YARD SALES, GARAGE SALES, RUMMAGE SALES, BASEMENT SALES
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF KINGSTON.

THE VILLAGE OF KINGSTON ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That it shall hereafter be unlawful to conduct a garage sale, yard sale, rummage sale, basement sale, or any similar sale without a permit issued by the Chief of Police. The sale shall be for no more than ten (10) days per year per household in any combination of days. All signs advertising the sale shall have the sellers name, address and dates of the sale. The signs must be picked up within two (2) days after each sale period. Failure to comply will result in the possible denial of future permits.

SECTION 2. Any violation of or any failure to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed 90 days or both.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be published in a paper that has general circulation for the Village of Kingston and County of Tuscola qualified under state law to publish legal notices, within two weeks after its adoption and the same shall be recorded in the Ordinance book of the Village and such recording authenticated by the signatures of the President and Village Clerk.

SECTION 4. If any section, part of section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions hereof shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective after publication in the Tuscola County Advertiser and shall take effect on January 1, 1998.


