

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT CERTAIN ACTIVITY DURING CITY OF WYANDOTTE SPONSORED/ COORDINATED EVENTS

THE CITY OF WYANDOTTE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Findings and Purpose.

Whereas the City of Wyandotte sponsors, coordinates or permits certain special events within the City of Wyandotte to serve a large number of visitors and whereas certain streets, sidewalks, parking lots and other areas have been blocked off to traffic in order to accommodate the great number of individuals who partake in the special events, it is necessary to prohibit certain activity in order to accommodate the large crowds and to ensure that everyone will be able to have an opportunity to enjoy the various activities. Because there is a limited amount of area in which to conduct these special events activities, it is necessary to prohibit certain activities.

Section 2. Special Events Defined.

“Special Events” as used in this Ordinance shall include the Spring Fling, Hot Country Jam, Annual Wyandotte Street Art Fair, Wyandotte Waterfest and other similar type events within the City of Wyandotte.

Section 3. Unlawful Activities.

A City resolution preceding the Special Event shall define the area where the Special Event is permitted. It shall be unlawful for any person at any Special Event to do any of the following within the area where said Special Event is to be held:

- (A) Bring any animal (including fish or reptile) to the Special Event, whether with a leash or not, unless said animal is part of an event as authorized by the City of Wyandotte or other sponsor of the Special Event.
- (B) Bring any bicycle or unicycle into the area where the Special Event is conducted. It is permissible to place the bicycle or unicycle in any bicycle rack which is provided.
- 8 Bring any skateboard, roller skates, roller blades, or other similar device into the Special Event Area.
- (D) Take or carry any radio, tape player, stereo, boom box, speakers or other device which transmits music or sound into the Special Event area. It is permissible for an individual to wear a headphone radio device sometimes known as a “WALKMAN”.

Section 4. Violations.

Should any individual violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, and if said individual shall refuse to come into compliance with the ordinance requirement after being provided a verbal warning by a police officer, then the police officer is authorized to issue a civil infraction for said violation.

Section 5. Penalties.

Any person who violates the terms of this ordinance is guilty of a civil infraction which shall carry with it a fine not to exceed \$100.00 along with court costs.

Section 6. Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.

Section 7. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days from the date of its passage by the Wyandotte City Council and shall be published in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Wyandotte.
