Saving Our Children – The Community’s Role in Suicide Prevention March 20, 2012

During a single month in 2010, 13 Farmington Hills middle school students threatened or attempted suicide. It is the third leading cause of death for 15-24 year-olds nationally. By developing a local suicide prevention plan, municipal officials can help make our communities safer, more inclusive places where people want to live, work, and play. When people are included and valued, they have more tools to deal with adversity and don't feel as isolated.

Sometimes it takes a community to save a child— the Farmington Hills Area Suicide Prevention Task Force and others will share what they’ve learned to help you confront this epidemic on your own home-front. Topics will include citizen resources, task force organization, and the importance of inclusion in suicide prevention.
