Michigan Local Government Management Association Honors Mark Wollenweber

Award Given During Michigan Municipal League Convention

GRAND RAPIDS (Oct. 12, 2011) – Long-time city manager Mark Wollenweber received the 2011 Patriarche Colloquium Award for his continued service to Michigan communities spanning nearly four decades.

The highest honor given by the Michigan Local Government Managers Association (MLGMA), the John M. Patriarche Distinguished Service Award was created in 1992 and recognizes past members who have fostered representative democracy by enhancing the effectiveness of local elected officials through innovative programs and excellence in character and professionalism.

Wollenweber, a former member of the Michigan Municipal League Board of Trustees and past MLGMA President, has served in management roles in multiple Michigan communities, including Grosse Pointe Woods, St. Clair Shores, Huntington Woods, Plymouth, and Westland.

“His service to our profession has been exemplary,” said MLGMA President Steve Brock in making the announcement during the annual MLGMA Patriarche Colloquium & Lunch held Oct. 6, 2011, during the League’s 2011 Convention in Grand Rapids. “He served on the board of MLGMA as well as served as president in 1989-90. He has been on, and probably chaired, all major committees of the state association. In addition, he was an ICMA Midwest regional vice president. He has been, and continues to be, a friend and mentor to many MLGMA members.”
