

INFORMATION TO COMPLETE JOBS TODAY APPLICATION

County Number - Please enter the county number. The numbers are 01 through 83 for each county in alphabetical order with Alcona 01 and Wexford 83.

State Senate District - If you have more than one district, use the number(s) where the project is located. See your MML of CRAM directory if you are not sure of the district number.

State House District - If you have more than one district, use the number(s) where the project is located. See your MML of CRAM directory if you are not sure of the district number.

Applicant - Identify either the road commission or City or Village applying in appropriate space

Rural Task Force/ MPO - Provide the Rural Task Force number (e.g. 13A) or your MPO initials (e.g. SEMOG).

HPP ID# - This number is listed in the first column of the HPP project list attached.

Job Number - This is the project number, assigned by MDOT when programming information is submitted to MDOT's Planning Division. See your MPO or Rural Task Force list of projects.

Route Name - e.g. Ottawa Street.

Project Limits - e.g. from 1st Street to 2nd Street.

Project Description/ Work Type - e.g. reconstruct roadway with enclosed drainage, including new traffic signal & permanent signing.

Environmental Clearance Classification - Categorical Exclusion (CE), Environmental Assessment(EA) , Environmental Impact statement (EIS) - To be determined by the Local Engineer based on type of work, please contact MDOT LAP if there are any questions about the environmental classification.

Current STIP Year - Provide the fiscal year that the project is currently scheduled for construction (See 2006-2009 current STIP. A fiscal year is defined as Oct 1-Sept 30.

Proposed STIP/TIP Construction Year - Provide year that the project will be constructed, this will be either 2006 or 2007 to comply with the requirements of the legislation.

Estimated Grade Inspection (GI) Date - Generally 4.5 months prior to Letting. Projects that are proposed to be moved into 2006 may get an expedited date. Some projects may have already had a GI scheduled.

Estimated Let Date - Use information provided in FY 2006 Planning Guide on MDOT LAP website as an estimate for letting dates. All projects must be in a letting date no latter than September of 07. Keep in mind that projects that are to be move into 06 may get moved quicker through the system.

Funding Amount - Under the Funding Amount heading are several sub headings for funding. Please provide the amount for each, the Federal funds shall match amount approved in the STIP/TIP on the day of enactment of legislation.
