- WHAT:** Responding to Gov. Rick Snyder's invitation to offer government reforms, the Michigan Municipal League (MML) unveils its 21st Century Communities Legislative Proposal of reforms to reduce some local government costs and improve efficiencies.

- DETAILS:** Transportation systems, the infrastructure, economic development, and education in Michigan must shift to keep up with the 21st Century economy and to keep young, college educated and talented people living in the state. Livable communities with multiple transportation options, access to entrepreneurial activities, and places that are attractive to knowledge industries and their employees are key. Government reforms that lower government costs in some areas, improve efficiencies, and create these types of places are necessary.
