



SELECTING A NEW OCCUPATIONAL CLINIC

Prior to scheduling a visit to meet with a potential clinic, it is recommended that you verify the following:

- Do they accept workers' compensation?
- Do they have adequate hours of operation?
- Are they designated as an occupational clinic?

If the clinic does not accept workers' compensation, have adequate hours to service you, or lacks designation as an occupational clinic, you will want to look elsewhere.

Things to Take With You to the Clinic Visit

- Municipality Contact Information
- Meadowbrook Claims Services (MML) Contact Information

Discussion Points

- What is the clinic's commitment to safety, employees and quality care?
- What is the clinic's process to communicate with you following each office visit?
- What is their return to work philosophy?
- If you have a light duty policy, are they willing to incorporate into their care?
- What is the average wait time for employees to be seen?
- What out-patient services are performed: physical therapy? Imaging?
- What is the clinic's procedure in dispensing opioid pain medication?
- Is the clinic willing to contact Meadowbrook/MML for all specialist referrals made?
