DIVISION 3. - DEPOSIT OF SNOW ON OTHER PROPERTY

Sec. 30-71. - Depositing snow on streets, sidewalks or alleys prohibited; exception.

Sec. 30-72. - Depositing snow on private property prohibited; permission of owner required.

Sec. 30-73. - Clearing of intersections.

Sec. 30-74. - Ordered removal of snow ice or other material.

Sec. 30-71. - Depositing snow on streets, sidewalks or alleys prohibited; exception.

It shall be unlawful for the persons in control of any property within the city to deposit snow from said property onto the streets, alleys or sidewalks in the city, subject only to the following exception: Snow may be deposited upon streets and alleys in the city, provided that this is done before the city equipment has plowed said streets and alleys, and may be done only when snow is deposited evenly along said street and alley and not into piles.

Sec. 30-72. - Depositing snow on private property prohibited; permission of owner required.

It shall be unlawful for any person having control of said property to deposit snow from said property upon any private property without first having obtained permission of the persons in control of the property upon which said snow is being deposited.

Sec. 30-73. - Clearing of intersections.

It shall be unlawful for the owners in charge of any property to accumulate snow at any intersection of the city streets, either on or off private property, in excess of 3% feet in height, or in any other way which would impede vision for motorists. The city may use its equipment to remove snow from certain intersections which are considered to be specially hazardous to traffic on account of accumulation of snow by use of its own equipment, but such removal shall be within the absolute discretion of the city and only at such times as the city equipment will be available after having first performed snow removal which the city considers to be of first importance.

Sec. 30-74. - Ordered removal of snow ice or other material.

In the event that snow, ice, or other material is piled in violation of this division at such times as the city equipment is not available for the removal of said snow, or ice or other material, the city may order the person in charge of said property to remove said material to the extent that proper vision and safety shall be maintained. This provision and other provisions of this division shall not apply to the accumulation of piles of snow as a result of public plowing of streets or alleys.
